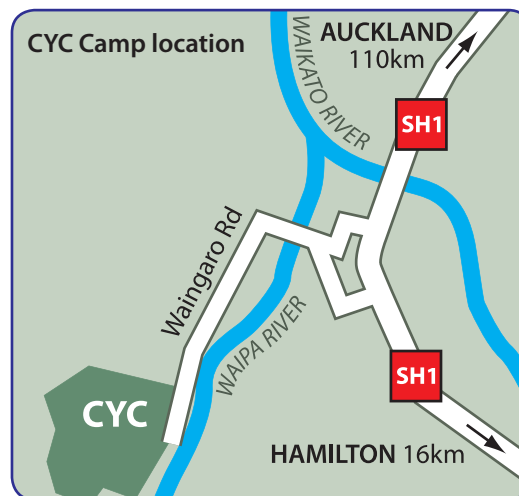

Christian Youth Camp (CYC), Waingaro Road, Ngaruawahia.

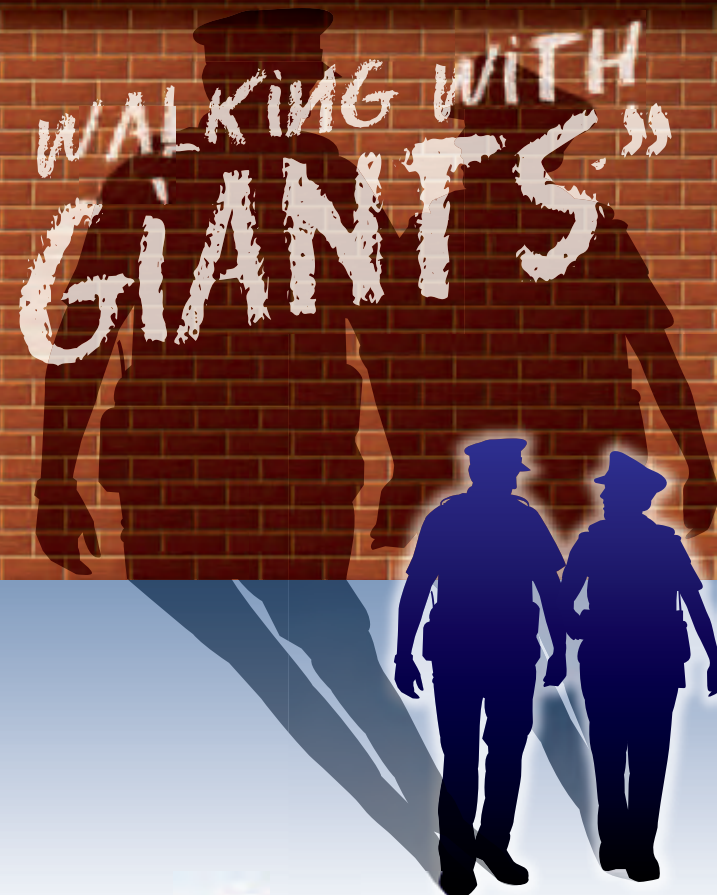
